

Swan River Garbage - Guidelines

(This is not authoritative nor comprehensive; if anything in this document contradicts the Bylaw No. 5/2013; that bylaw is final authority)

Your Bin

- Owner shall have garbage bins in good shape.
 - Can have up to 2 maximum 32 gal. cans.
 - Metal or Plastic
 - with a lid (watertight)



Putting Garbage Out

- Garbage is collected weekly
 - Know your zone!
 - Check the calendar online to know what day your zone gets picked up
- Put your garbage out by 7:00 AM to ensure you don't get missed
- Make sure to put your bins out where the collectors can easily see and pick it up
 - Put them out by the lane, or in the place designated for pick up
 - Don't place them on the road or sidewalk
- Don't forget to take your bin back once the garbage has been picked up.

Rules on Garbage

- Ensure all garbage is in bags and sealed so it doesn't make a mess
- The garbage bin is for standard household garbage. If you're not sure if your garbage is acceptable give us a call to confirm.
- Don'ts!
 - Don't go over 45lb of garbage
 - Don't put anything too big (nothing four feet long)
 - Don't put in anything hazardous (explosive, flammable)
