Are you aware of the Safer Communities and Neighborhoods Act?

This provincial act works by holding property owners accountable for threatening or disturbing activities that regularly take place on their property including unlawful drug use or dealing, production or cultivation, prostitution, sexual abuse or exploitation of children, criminal organization, or possession of weapons.

The process starts when one or more residents files a complaint with Manitoba Justice.
 The complaint is kept confidential. The identity of those who file it cannot be revealed at any time.
