### Employment Opportunity Summer Youth Camp Worker – Full Time (Seasonal Term)

The Town of Swan River Recreation Department is accepting applications for up to 4 seasonal positions of Summer Youth Camp Workers for six (6) weeks of summer programming.

Employment Date: July 6 – August 14, 2026

Working hours: Weekdays from 8:45 a.m. – 4:15 p.m.

Under the general supervision of the Youth Summer Coordinator, a Seasonal Youth Camp Worker shall assist in the delivery of summer camp programming by supporting activities, supervising participants, and contributing to a safe, engaging, and positive camp environment.

Typical duties include:

- Delivering designated summer activities, events, and trips as set by the Youth Coordinator;
- Motivating and promoting an upbeat, positive, and creative play environment for campers;
- Teaching and modelling appropriate social interactions;
- Ensuring a safe and clean play environment for campers; and
- Participating in planned activities alongside campers.

#### Qualifications:

Applicants are required to have the following to be eligible for employment:

- Must be between 15 and 29 years of age at the time of employment;
- Must be a Manitoba resident;
- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada;
- Must possess a valid Social Insurance Number; and
- Must comply with all additional requirements as outlined in the Manitoba Green Team Program Guidelines, including any applicable youth employment restrictions and employer program conditions.

Additional Requirements:

- Strong interest in working with children in a recreation setting;
- Ability to work as part of a team in a fast-paced environment; and
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills are considered an asset.

Start and end dates of position can be negotiated.
